What is the NCGA Fiscal Research Internship Program?

The NCGA Fiscal Research Internship Program is a paid 10-week summer program that offers students an opportunity to work with the <u>Fiscal Research Division</u> (FRD), the primary budget and finance staff to the NCGA. You will be assigned to one or more FRD teams who will mentor you through your project and help you develop your analytical and communication skills. You will work on challenging and relevant fiscal research projects with a team of highly skilled and collegial professionals. You will not only gain valuable skills and knowledge, but also make a difference in the state.

As an NCGA Fiscal Research intern, you will:

- Gain practical experience and exposure to the budget process and fiscal policy issues
- Learn from our team of experienced and knowledgeable fiscal analysts
- Collaborate with other interns and staff across different policy areas and disciplines
- Contribute to the development and evaluation of the State budget and other legislation
- Enhance your résumé and network with potential employers
- Be paid \$18.25 per hour

To be eligible for the NCGA Fiscal Research Internship Program, you must:

- Be enrolled in a full-time graduate-level degree program in public policy, public administration, economics, business management, or a related field
- Have a strong academic record and research interest
- Have excellent communication and teamwork skills
- Be able to work cooperatively and maintain composure under pressure
