


These charts and tables were created by the Fiscal Research Division, a nonpartisan central staff division serving all members of the North Carolina House of Representatives and State Senate.

General Fund Actual Spending by Area (\$ in billions)



This chart reflects spending by budget area from the State General Fund. See page two for table of exact figures.

Notes:

- (1) This chart reflects actual spending, not the amount budgeted for expenditure.
- (2) Chart reflects net operating expenditures from the State General Fund, excluding federal funds and other departmental receipts. Net General Fund appropriations for capital improvements are also excluded.
- (3) General Fund expenditures do not reflect the entirety of all State spending in a given year.
- (4) "All Other" areas include Natural & Economic Resources, General Government, Justice & Public Safety, and Capital & Information Technology.

(5) This chart does not adjust for inflation.
