Conference Committee on General Government

Selected Agency Budget Highlights

The Conference Committee budget proposal for General Government agencies totals \$517.8 million, excluding agency receipts, in General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22, which is \$88.6 million or 20.6% more than the base budget for FY 2021-22. The FY 2022-23 budget is \$494.1 million, excluding agency receipts, which is \$64.9 million or 15.1% more than the base budget for FY 2022-23.

The Conference Budget includes \$910 million from the State Fiscal Recovery Fund.

Selected highlights from the House Budget proposal for General Government agencies follow below.

Department of Administration (DOA)

Committee Report Items

- (Page F9, Item 6) Provides federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) funds for the RETOOLNC Program, which administers grants to small, historically underutilized businesses (\$20 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).
- (Page F10, Items 14-15) Provides additional funds for organizations that provide services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault (\$1,000,000 recurring).

Office of State Budget and Management

Committee Report Items

- (Page F37, Item 65) Provides ARP funds to the League of Municipalities for the creation of an audit software grant program for tracking local use of funds related to the COVID-19 pandemic (\$15 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).
- (Page F37, Item 66) Provides ARP funds for guidance and technical assistance to localities in the administration of Local Recovery Funds. These funds will be distributed evenly between the League of Municipalities, the Association of County Commissioners, and the Regional Councils of Government (\$30 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).
- (Page F37, Item 66) Provides ARP funds for the Towns of Apex and Huntersville to backfill for the gap in ARP federal funds due to a funding formula issue (\$23.5 M nonrecurring in FY 2022-22).
- (Page F37, Item 67) Provides ARP funds to State-recognized American Indian tribes to respond to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic (\$10 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).



General Assembly (NCGA)

Committee Report Items

• (Page F73, Item 138) Provides ARP funds to support the legislature's response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including improvements in information technology (IT) and the legislative complex (\$21.8 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22, including \$2.35 M for premium pay and bonuses to essential workers; \$11 M for staff resources; \$8 M for broadband/other technology improvements and committee room enhancements; and \$450,000 to offset revenue losses in legislative food services revenue).

Housing Finance Agency (HFA)

Committee Report Items

• (Page F89, Item 159) Provides ARP funds for the Workforce Housing Loan Program (\$170 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).

Department of Insurance (DOI)

Committee Report Items

• (Page F109, Item 187) Provides ARP funds to for a \$10,000 base grant to each eligible unit to help mitigate revenue losses to the volunteer fire departments across the State due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic (\$8 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).

Special Provisions

- (Section 30.2) Modifies current law to waive the existing Volunteer Fire Department Grant Fund program's local matching requirements for grants to purchase firefighter equipment.
- (Section 30.3) Suspends collections of worker's compensation premiums from members of participating local fire and rescue units. Payments of claims resulting during the biennium will be paid from the special fund cash balance.

Department of Military & Veterans Affairs (DMVA)

Committee Report Items

- (Page F138, Item 243) Provides funds to continue support for various activities focused on maintaining the military presence and defense industry across the State (\$1 M nonrecurring in FY 2022-23; S.L. 2020-24 appropriated an additional \$2 M nonrecurring for FY 2020-21).
- (Page F140, Item 247) Provides additional funds to increase the number of scholarships awarded to eligible children of disabled veterans (\$2 M recurring from the Escheat Fund).

- (Page F143, Item 253) Provides funds for the required match for an anticipated construction grant to build a new veterans skilled nursing facility in Wake County (\$30 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).
- (Page F143, Item 257) Provides funds for a directed grant to The Independence Fund, Inc. to expand a justice intervention pilot for veterans across the State (\$2 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).

Department of Revenue (DOR)

Committee Report Items

• (Page F154, Item 275) Establishes the Business Recovery Grant Program using ARP funds to provide economic support to businesses that suffered substantial economic damage from the COVID-19 pandemic (\$500 M nonrecurring in FY 2021-22).

Special Provisions

• (Section 34.3A) Directs DOR to allocate the Business Recovery Grant Program funds between Hospitality Grants for businesses in the arts, entertainment, recreation, accommodations, and food services industries, and Reimbursement Grants for businesses in all other industries.
