Dedication Set Today

North Carolina's new Legislative Building, completed nearly two years ago, will be formally dedicated in ceremonies here today at 11 a.m.

Chief Justice Emery B. Denny of the State Supreme Court will pronounce the official dedication of the \$6.2 million glassand-marble structure on Halifax Street. State Sen. Clarence Stone, president of the Senate, will accept the building for the Legislature.


Dignitaries from across the State will be on hand for the ceremonies. Merobers of General Assembly sessions held since building plans began in 1959 have been invited as special guests. State, city and county government officials round out the invitation list.
